You will know if you have it by the bullseye-like mark on your skin. You can cure it with Clotrimazole cream, that can be found in athlete's foot cream. This same procedure should be used for barefooted fans. This is contagious. Be careful around pets and loved ones, hot water and detergent for clothes and bedding. Don't cover it. There are the traditional ways to contract ringworm, but this one few know and its common here.




