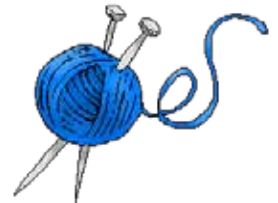
## RICE CREEK STITCHERS

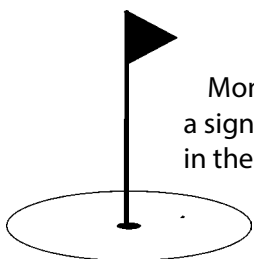

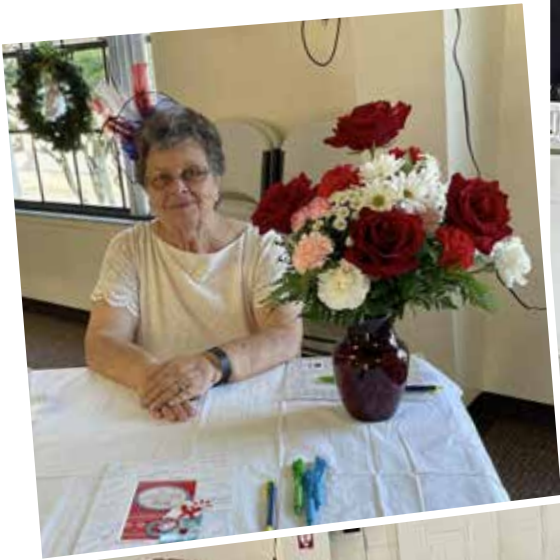

# Some Interesting Facts About Tampa

## Cigars

Though Cuban cigars are associated with Cuba, they were made here in Tampa for many years, earning the city one of its popular nicknames, the Cigar City.

## Authors

Two famous authors have lived in the area: Jack Kerouac, the beat poet and novelist of the 1960's who lived in St Petersburg, and Stephen King, the popular horror writer who lives in Sarasota. Both authors were originally from New England.

## The Cuban sandwich was invented in Tampa

The difference between a Cuban sandwich in Tampa and a Cuban sandwich in Miami is that in Tampa they added Genoa salami due to the large population of Italian immigrants involved in the cigar trade.

## Tampa Bay is incredibly shallow

At only 12-feet deep, Tampa Bay is shallow, and it is also the largest estuary in Florida – defined as having both salt and fresh water mixed together. Channels are dredged to allow ships to navigate the water in and around the port.

## Port Tampa Bay is the largest in Florida

It is situated 25 miles from the Gulf of Mexico and generates over \$15 billion in revenue.

## Cowboys came to Florida

## Bayshore Boulevard has the longest continuous sidewalk at 4.5 miles

This path runs entirely along the water. It's a great place to walk, run or bike. You will see historic mansions and feel fresh sea breezes. Sightings of manatees and dolphins are a common occurrence.

## Tampa holds a flight history record

Tampa is home to the first scheduled commercial flight in 1914, which landed here after taking off from St. Petersburg

## Babe Ruth hit his longest home run in Tampa

Interesting bit of history – The Great Bambino's longest home run was hit at the old Plant Field baseball stadium in downtown Tampa. In April 1919, during a spring training game of the Red Sox vs. the NY Giants, the baseball legend hit a record breaking 587-foot homer.

## RECIPES



What's in season in February? Broccoli, Brussels sprouts, cabbage, cauliflower, kale, lemons, oranges, squash, sweet potatoes, and strawberries!

### Roasted Vegetables

1 pound broccoli, washed and trimmed  
1 pound brussels sprouts, washed and trimmed  
1 pound cauliflower, washed and trimmed  
2 whole garlic cloves, sliced thin  
2 Tablespoons olive oil  
Salt and pepper to taste

Preheat oven to 400 degrees.

Wash brussels sprouts, broccoli and cauliflower (or any combination of vegetables you prefer). Cut the stems from the brussels sprouts and cut in halves or quarters depending on their size. Cut broccoli crowns from the stalks into 1-2 inch pieces. Cut cauliflower into 1-2 inch pieces. Make sure the vegetables are very dry.

In a large bowl, combine the vegetables, garlic, salt, pepper and olive oil and toss until the vegetables are evenly coated with the olive oil.

Spread the vegetables evenly on a sheet pan (I like to cover the sheet pan with foil or parchment paper for easy cleanup) Place the sheet pan in the oven for 35 to 40 minutes, tossing halfway through to roast on all sides.

These delicious veggies can be paired with just about any kind of meat! I love them with grilled salmon!

Since February 22 is National Margarita Day, here is a recipe to try:

### Margarita

1 ½ ounce silver tequila  
1 ounce orange liqueur (*Cointreau, Grand Marnier or Triple Sec*)  
¾ ounce freshly squeezed lime juice  
Optional sweetener: agave nectar or simple syrup, to taste  
Lime wedge and coarse salt for rimming the glass

Run a lime wedge around the top rim of your serving glass. Fill a shallow bowl or plate with salt, then dip the rim until it is covered with salt. Set aside.

In a shaker over ice, combine liquid ingredients, cover and shake for about 10 seconds. Give it a taste to check for sweetness. Strain the cocktail into your prepared glass and enjoy!
