#### Message from the President

Greetings, Featherock Residents!

It looks like Spring has Sprung! Hopefully, this Quill finds everyone doing well!

First of all, I would like to say "So Long" to one of our residents. If you have not heard, Karen Merwin, who has been living with us for several years, passed away in March. Karen was an active part of our Water Aerobics, was on our Welcome Committee, and even delivered Quills from time to time. We will miss her, and I am confident she is at Peace now, at the feet of her Savior. All who knew Karen loved her.

I know we have mentioned this before, but with Karen's passing this is a good time to bring it up again. If you live alone or if both of you are up in years, it makes sense to have another family member on your title. We are never promised "tomorrow" so protect yourselves by securing your home by having another family member on your title.

Well, if you have not heard by "word or mouth" or at the March Board Meeting, we had our Mediation Meeting with ELS on February 21st. The meeting was attended by members of our Statutory Committee, along with our Attorney, and ELS Corporate Regional Managers and their Attorney. We presented a very good case for them to reduce the 5.75% rent increase to a more manageable amount, but they declined to budge. Their Attorney said they felt they were where they wanted to be to be in line with other rents in the area. After all was said and presented, they said they would be willing to drop their original 5.75% by one half of one percent and they would put some pool furniture at the pool, which is nothing, and unacceptable. For any reduction they would offer we would have to sign an agreement that we would not litigate for any past problems, which again was unacceptable.

If you have not seen the repairs made to the north pool pavilion, look. We have only been asking for those repairs to be done for a little over a year. Well, it has finally been done. Our electronic sign at the front of the park has been sitting there, unable to be used, for well over a year, and it still is not functional. We have broken pool furniture and broken tables at the Clubhouse, and instead of repairing or replacing them, our Management Team just removes them. These are just some of the things that we have been bringing to the attention of Management for quite some time.

After discussions with our Attorney, he believes that we would have a good case if we decided to take ELS to court for the lack of services we have received, along with the lack of attention to the conditions of the park over the past couple of years. With that being said, we will be having a special meeting with our resident and our Attorney in the upcoming days, to get an idea of what would be needed and/or accomplished with filing a lawsuit against ELS. As we move forward be watching for details of that meeting with our Attorney. He believes that due to our Clubhouse being closed for seven months and the fact that we are so frequently without management on campus, we have a good case. We will get the information out as best as we can so we can have a respectable number of our residents at that meeting.

*(continued from page 1)* I know this news is not the news you want to hear but we did our best to present to ELS that they could not justify the rent increase they gave us. We feel that we are being forced into an area where we have never been before, all because of the lack of concern for our residents by our park Owner and their demand for profits for their investors. ELS is a publicly traded company, so their profits are published. In the first nine months of 2023 the company reported making over \$288 million dollars. We feel they need to put more of that money back into our park to make it a better place to live.

I just want to remind everyone that, as usual, our BINGO will be shutting down after the last Monday in May, for the summer. We will close down for June and July, giving our BINGO workers a chance to relax and travel to visit family. We will start back on the first Monday in August with BINGO and our Bingo Kitchen. See you at an event soon!

#### Mensaje del Presidente

¡Saludos residentes de Featherock! ¡Parece que la primavera ha llegado! ¡Esperemos que esta pluma encuentre a todos bien!

En primer lugar, me gustaría decir "Hasta luego" a uno de nuestros residentes. Si no lo has escuchado, Karen Merwin, guien ha estado viviendo con nosotros durante varios años, falleció en marzo. Karen fue parte activa de nuestros aeróbicos acuáticos, formó parte de nuestro Comité de Bienvenida e incluso entregó Quills de vez en cuando. La echaremos de menos, y estoy seguro de que ahora está en paz, a los pies de su Salvador. Todos los que conocían a Karen la guerían. Sé que hemos mencionado esto antes, pero con el fallecimiento de Karen, este es un buen momento para volver a mencionarlo. Si vives solo o si ambos son mayores de edad, tiene sentido tener otro miembro de la familia en tu título. Nunca se nos promete "mañana", así que protéjanse asegurando su casa al tener otro miembro de la familia en su título.

Bueno, si no ha escuchado "de palabra o de boca" o en la reunión de la junta directiva de marzo, tuvimos nuestra reunión de mediación con ELS el 21 de febrero. A la reunión asistieron miembros de nuestro Comité Estatutario, junto con nuestro Abogado, y los Gerentes Regionales Corporativos de ELS y su Abogado. Presentamos un muy buen caso para que redujeran el aumento del alquiler del 5.75% a una cantidad más manejable, pero se negaron a ceder. Su abogado dijo que sentían que estaban donde querían estar para estar en línea con otros alquileres en el área. Después de todo lo dicho y presentado, dijeron que estarían dispuestos a bajar su 5.75% original en la mitad del uno por ciento y que pondrían algunos muebles de piscina en la piscina, lo cual no es nada e inaceptable. Para cualquier reducción que nos ofrecieran, tendríamos que firmar un acuerdo por el que no litigaríamos por ningún problema pasado, lo que también era inaceptable.

Si no has visto las reparaciones que se han hecho en el pabellón de la piscina norte, mira. Solo hemos estado pidiendo que se hagan esas reparaciones durante poco más de un año. Pues bien, por fin se ha hecho. Nuestro letrero electrónico en la parte delantera del parque ha estado allí, sin poder ser utilizado, durante más de un año, y todavía no funciona. Tenemos muebles de piscina rotos y mesas rotas en la Casa Club, y en lugar de repararlos o reemplazarlos, nuestro equipo de administración simplemente los quita. Estas son solo algunas de las cosas que hemos estado llamando la atención de la Administración durante bastante tiempo.

Después de las discusiones con nuestro abogado, él cree que tendríamos un buen caso si decidiéramos llevar a ELS a los tribunales por la falta de servicios que hemos recibido, junto con la falta de atención a las condiciones del parque en los últimos años. Dicho esto, tendremos una reunión especial con nuestro residente y nuestro abogado en los próximos días, para tener una idea de lo que se necesitaría y / o lograría con la presentación de una demanda contra ELS. A medida que avanzamos, estén atentos a los detalles de esa reunión con nuestro abogado. Él cree que debido a que nuestra Casa Club estuvo cerrada durante siete meses y al hecho de que con tanta frecuencia estamos sin administración en campus, tenemos un buen caso. Difundiremos la información lo mejor que podamos para que podamos tener un número respetable de nuestros residentes en esa reunión. Sé que esta noticia no es la noticia que quieres escuchar, pero hicimos todo lo posible para presentarle a ELS que no podían justificar el aumento de alquiler que nos dieron. Sentimos que estamos siendo forzados a entrar en un (continúa en la página 3)

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
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## Featherrock's Hidden Gems




